## Detailed Itinerary:

**Days 1 & 2: THE ELEPHANT CAMP, Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe (meals, selected beverages and selected activities)**

**Travel time: Victoria Falls Airport – The Elephant Camp approx 20 min drive**

On arrival at Victoria Falls Airport, proceed through customs and immigration, where you are met by a local representative for the onwards road transfer to The Elephant Camp where you are booked for 2 nights in a luxury suite on a full board basis. Included in your stay are complimentary transfers to town and meeting the Wild Horizons elephants if you are in camp during their evening walk.

Situated on a private concession within and bounded by the Masuwe River and Zambezi gorges, The Elephant Camp has breathtaking views of the Victoria Falls' spray, and the spectacular gorges that separate Zimbabwe from Zambia. The Elephant Camp is a luxury and intimate lodge under canvas within easy reach of Victoria Falls and all its attractions and activities, yet secluded in its own private game reserve so as to allow close-up encounters with wildlife.

The Elephant Camp offers exclusive suite accommodation up to 24 guests in 12 luxury tents with an additional West Wing operating a separate camp, more family orientated with 4 luxury tents hosting up to 16 guests, catering to families.

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All suites face the gorge and offer a private viewing deck, plunge pool, private lounge area, air-conditioning and fans, mini bar and tea and coffee stations. All suites are mosquito proofed with mosquito nets. The en-suite facilities include a bath as well as an inside and outside shower so that you can shower under the starry skies of Zimbabwe.

The main complex with a spacious deck, lounge, bar and dining area is a tented structure leading onto a pool offering sweeping vistas of the Batoka Gorge and at high water level the magnificent spray of the Victoria Falls.

The Elephant Camp offers close interaction with wildlife – in particular elephant at the Wild Horizons Wildlife Sanctuary. All guests will have the opportunity of meeting the elephants at the Wild Horizons Elephant Sanctuary. Additional inclusions for 2016 are: sundowners at Batoka Gorge, Birding and Nature walks on the concession and lunch at the Lookout Café (on request). All other activities on offer in Victoria Falls as well as Spa treatments are available at an additional cost and can be booked at the lodge. The Camp offers two transfers to Victoria Falls town per day at no further cost.

### AREA DESCRIPTION – VICTORIA FALLS

Victoria Falls town lies on the southern bank of the Zambezi River at the eastern end of the Victoria Falls. It is a lovely tourist town which is easy to explore on foot and which offers a wide range of activities from the challenge of white water rafting and bungi jumping, to the awe-inspiring elephant back safaris and sunset cruises. It has something for everyone. The Victoria Falls are one of the Seven Wonders of the World and is the largest sheet of falling water on earth - a spellbinding and mesmerising spectacle. The sheer mass of water cascading down the 100m drop across nearly 2km makes a thunderous roar and creates a magnificent spray of water that can be seen for miles - hence the local name 'mosi oa tunya' meaning 'the smoke that thunders'. Access to Victoria Falls is within easy walking distance from the town centre. Water flow over the falls varies throughout the year. The river's annual flood season is February to May when the spray can reach a height of over 400m, this is spectacular from above but it makes it very difficult to see the falls at ground level as it is under a heavy shower/mist. Water levels start dropping in August and are at their lowest October - December when much of the rocky face becomes dry. At times of low water, the falls are best viewed from the Zimbabwe side, by helicopter on the 'flight of angels' or from Livingstone Island (Zambian side).

**Days 3, 4 & 5: DUMA TAU, private Linyanti Wildlife Reserve (fully inclusive)**

**Travel time: The Elephant Camp – Duma Tau approx 2 hours road to Kasane and approx 40 min flight**

After breakfast you will transfer by road to the Kazungula border post and proceed through Zimbabwe customs, and escorted through Botswana customs for onwards road transfer to Kasane Airport, where you are met and assisted with the onwards light aircraft transfer to Duma Tau Camp for the following 3 nights on a fully inclusive basis.

*Please note that the flight is booked on a 'seat rate' basis and therefore flight times are not scheduled until the day prior to flying, the lodge management will arrange your activities and transfers accordingly. Please note that there is a strict luggage restriction on all light aircraft flights of 15kg per person in soft bags, plus hand luggage.*

Duma Tau Camp (meaning 'roar of the lion') is a luxury tented camp located in the private 125 000-hectare Linyanti Wildlife Reserve that borders the western boundary of Chobe National Park in Northern Botswana. Duma Tau was completely rebuilt in 2012 in a new location in the original concession, overlooking the Osprey Lagoon.

The 10 luxury tented rooms (8 twin and 2 family) are on raised decking and constructed with canvas walls under cooling thatch rooves. Each tent has an en-suite bathroom to the side (partitioned off not a separate room as such) with an indoor and an outside shower as well as his and hers basins.

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The classic style of the camp evokes the age of the explorers along with an incredible sense of space, with the main area offering a variety of seating, lounge and dining areas to suit the different seasons and create a haven from which to enjoy the incredible view. The camp is now powered completely using solar energy, as per the hot water system, creating an energy efficient and low impact on the environment.



The region has all the habitat diversity to make it a haven for wildlife, and is a major a 'corridor' of movement for elephant concentrations as they congregate along the waterways and lagoons during the dry winter months. Day and night game viewing is conducted in open 4x4 vehicles along the Savuti Channels and the banks of the Linyanti River. Guided walks along the river provide fantastic opportunities for a close up view of nature and birdlife in its own environment. Game viewing hides are also provided in the area where guests can enjoy wildlife viewing close up and away from a vehicle. Water activities can be an option when the Linyanti River is in full flood which will take visitors along the waters of the Linyanti, with hippo and waterfowl viewings can be enjoyed.

Sleep-outs in the hide can be arranged on a minimum 3-night stay and are possible in two variations. If guests have NOT booked and paid for a private vehicle, then they go to the hide after dinner on the shared activity vehicle, and return early next morning for continental breakfast and morning activity with other guests. If they do book and pay for the Duma Tau private vehicle, then there is more flexibility re: times of departure and return. The Duma Tau hide is an elevated platform, equipped with bed rolls, mosquito nets and long drop toilet. Minimum age requirement is 12 years and older.

### LINYANTI & SELINDA

The Linyanti area lies to the north-east of the Okavango Delta where the Kwando and Linyanti rivers meet at right angles, forming a swamp area within this triangle. From here the Selinda Spillway seasonally makes its way down to the Zibadianja Lagoon and ultimately links the Linyanti River system with the far northern reaches of the Okavango Delta. The recent high water levels in Botswana have revived the old waterways, however in the not too distant past, it was nearly unheard of for the waters to connect and it is unpredictable what the future holds.

The area's relative remoteness makes it a favoured safari destination. The wildlife in the Linyanti area is spectacular and the region is famous for its enormous herds of elephant and buffalo which move to the Linyanti area at the start of the winter months and only move back inland once the summer rains arrive in November. The Linyanti is also known as one of the best wild dog areas in Africa. The dogs start denning anytime from June onwards after which they can usually be found with relative ease for 3-4 months afterwards as they hunt from their den. An abundance of cat species also frequent this area and the birdlife is rich with the best birding months being between October and January.


**Days 6 & 7: LITTLE VUMBURA CAMP, private Kwedi Concession Okavango Delta (fully inclusive)**

**Travel time: Duma Tau – Little Vumbura approx 25 min flight (plus stops en-route)**

Following breakfast and possible morning activity (flight times permitting) you transfer back to the airstrip for the light aircraft flight to Little Vumbura Camp. From the airstrip it is a road/boat transfer to camp, depending on water levels, here you stay the following 2 nights on fully inclusive basis.

Little Vumbura is situated on an island in a private concession in the northern part of the Okavango Delta, in the same region as its sister camp Vumbura Plains, in what is known locally as the Kwedi Reserve.

It is a beautiful six-roomed tented camp shaded by the canopy of an ancient Okavango forest. Each tent is large and roomy and has en-suite facilities. A plunge pool and reading area overlook the floodplains and a star deck leads off the dining and bar area which are set under a canvas canopy. An outdoor dining area on a wooden deck gives you the option of al fresco dinners on beautiful evenings.



Due to the location of the camp, both water and land based activities are offered. Little Vumbura has deep-water motor-boat trips into the permanent waterways and shallow-water excursions by mokoro, as well as, day and night game drives in open land rovers allowing guests to see animals at close ranges. Guided walks (on request) and fishing excursions are an excellent activity, options throughout the year.

Game viewing is consistently good all year round with lion, leopard, elephant, sable and buffalo along with extensive plains game providing an excellent all-round wildlife experience in this remote corner of the Delta. Little Vumbura is part of a community participation plan bringing the communities that live around the Okavango Delta into the tourism mainstream.

#### **AREA DESCRIPTION – OKAVANGO DELTA**

The Okavango Delta is one of the world's largest inland deltas situated in the middle of the largest stretch of continuous sand in the world - the Kalahari basin. This oasis in the middle of the desert is a rich yet fragile ecosystem, providing a life source for an incredible variety of wildlife. A wealth of species have adapted to the contrasting conditions created by living in the harsh Kalahari desert which is transformed annually with the arrival of the delta flood waters originating in Angola.

The Okavango wetland encompasses Moremi Game Reserve and surrounding regions divided into areas known as Private Concessions. These concessions are wildlife management areas, carefully administered to balance the growing community's development and conservation, whilst empowering citizens through sustainable tourism. Many of the exclusive lodges in Botswana are situated within these concessions in the delta, providing an unparalleled wildlife experience - exclusive and remote, avoiding mass tourism and exploitation.

Flood levels fluctuate dramatically throughout the year, with high water levels peaking in the central Okavango during the dry winter months and water levels at their lowest during the later summer months, contrary to the seasonal rainfall. The landscape, activities and game viewing vary considerably throughout the delta depending on your location, the season and flood levels. Some areas have larger tracts of permanent dry land which generally means there is more focus on land based activities (game drives) and big game viewing. Lodges situated on islands deep in the delta concentrate more on water activities such as mokoro excursions, walking, boating, fishing and bird watching. Those lodges situated on the outer fringes of the delta, referred to as the 'seasonal' delta, offer varied experiences at different times of the year - more water based during high flood levels and more land based as the flood recedes.

Game is more concentrated around the permanent water during the dry season (Apr - Oct) with it becoming very hot in the later months. The heronries become active as the migrant birds return to Botswana from September through November, and general bird watching is excellent throughout the summer months. The rainy season (Nov - Apr) invigorates the lush scenery with wild flowers, dramatic thundershowers, spectacular sunsets and the birthing season brings great predator and prey interaction.

**Day 8, 9 & 10 CHITABE LEDIBA CAMP, private Chitabe Concession bordering Moremi Game Reserve, Okavango Delta (fully inclusive)**

**Travel time: Little Vumbura- Chitabe  
Approx 30 min flight**

Following breakfast and possible morning activity (flight times permitting) you will transfer down to the private Chitabe Concession by light aircraft. Upon arrival at the Airstrip you are met by a representative from Chitabe Lediba Camp for onwards transfer in a safari vehicle to Chitabe Lediba Camp, where you spend the following 3 nights on a fully inclusive basis.

Chitabe Lediba camp lies in the Chitabe Concession which covers 28 000 hectares of pristine Okavango wilderness. It borders the well-known Moremi Game Reserve and is nestled between two main river systems, the Gomoti to the east and the Santantadibe to the west.

Situated in proximity to Chitabe Main Camp, the recently refurbished Chitabe Lediba camp offers an intimate and personal base from which to explore the wildlife rich Chitabe concession. Offering five

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accommodation tents including two family units with adjoining bedrooms and en-suite bathrooms, Chitabe Lediba suits small groups and families perfectly. Each of the spacious Meru-style tents are built on raised decks with luxurious interiors; en-suite bathrooms complement the outdoor shower "with a view." The family units have a large verandah with dining table to allow private dining options for families with younger children. The open dining area, lounge and pool offer glorious views over the surrounding floodplains and a small Lediba (remnant lagoon that has become a waterhole), after which the camp is named, where game comes to drink during the day.



Explore the area on morning and afternoon game drives, the evening drive usually returning after dark so as to get a chance at spotting the shy nocturnal animals such as genet, civet, serval, porcupine and possibly aardwolf. Other wildlife seen in the area includes elephants, buffalos, lions, leopards, cheetah as well as wild dog. What makes Chitabe unique even in the Okavango Delta is that it harbours such a variety of habitats within close proximity, ranging from classic Okavango scenery with Ilala palms dotting floodplains to open savannah and acacia woodlands. A finger of perennial swamps inundated by water throughout the year extends into the Chitabe Concession and the area is also dominated by seasonally flooded areas which transform over fifty percent of the concession from dry floodplains into a lush oasis, when the annual flood waters meander through. All this gives rise to a surprising diversity of species, which allows Chitabe to offer guests a wide range of game viewing and birding experiences.

**DAY 11: SAFARI ENDS IN MAUN**

**Travel time: Chitabe - Maun  
approx 20 min flight (plus stops en-route)**

Following breakfast and possible morning activity you will transfer back to the airstrip and then fly to Maun by light aircraft for own onwards travel arrangements.

## Special Notes

### Shared Transfers and Activities

Road, boat, air transfers and activities are quoted on a seat basis (on a shared basis and NOT private) unless otherwise requested or specified. Private charters/transfers can however be requested at an additional cost. Passengers may have various stops en-route to a destination adding to the duration of the transfer. International flight connections are accounted for in the daily schedules.

On shared transfers all the flight times are arranged a day before travel to avoid endless schedule changes. The transfer or charter company reserves the right to specify departure and arrival times.

### Weight and Luggage restrictions

Please advise upon requesting a quotation where a traveller **weighs over 100kg**, as well as at time of confirming the booking, as it may be necessary to cost in an additional seat on internal flights for the passenger's safety and comfort.

Luggage is restricted on flight transfers to **20kg per person in soft bags**, which includes all hand luggage and camera equipment. Please refer to your itinerary notes, as in some instances, and in some countries, such as Zambia and Zimbabwe this limitation is decreased to 15kg per person. Please note that luggage in excess of the above restrictions shall result in additional costs for transport and/or storage and should be arranged in advance. Note that laundry can be done on a daily basis at most camps and lodges.

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### **Health**

Please confirm that all Clients are medically fit, in good physical and mental health and that there is nothing which renders him/her unfit to undertake the tour at the time of booking. Any Client with a pre-existing medical condition or illness must declare the true nature of such conditions to the Company before the commencement of the tour.

The Client is responsible for attending to any medical condition which he/she may have and must consult with his/her physician in respect of all medical conditions which might be affected by his/her participation in the tour, activities or associated activities.

The Client accepts that certain areas included in the tour are malaria-infected areas and that he/she should take reasonable anti-malaria precautions.

### **Insurance**

Travel, cancellation and health insurance are highly recommended for all Clients.

### **Visas/Passports/Travel Documents**

The Client is solely responsible to ensure that his/her passports, visas, insurance cover and vaccination certificates, (and any other travel documents and/or requirements of any nature whatsoever) are valid for the duration of the tour and in the countries to be visited.

### **Arrival and Departure Details**

It is imperative that we have the correct International/Regional arrival and departure details for the clients in order to plan the itinerary and ensure efficient onward transfers. Costs may be incurred if these details are not given on quotation, or if they change subsequently.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

We require that you have read and understood our full **SAFARI INFORMATION** and **TERMS AND CONDITIONS** before confirming the itinerary and commencing the safari. However we would like to highlight the following important notes.

### **EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY**

In terms of the trading conditions, and any contract(s) concluded pursuant hereto, the Company acts as a booking agent only, for and on behalf of the Client in procuring services. The Company utilizes the products of various travel Subcontractors. The Company does not provide any direct services to the Clients as its services are limited to procuring and compiling tour packages for its clients.

While the Company makes every effort:

- to engage quality Subcontractors among the airlines, hotels, tour operators and other service providers to constitute the itinerary of the tour; and
- to ensure that the various services that constitutes the tour package will be carried out efficiently and as advertised;

it does not have direct control over the provision of services by Subcontractors and shall not be liable for *inter alia* any loss, damage, injury, additional costs, delay or irregularity that may be occasioned by an error or default, act or omission of any Subcontractor in carrying out the logistics of the tour package, or associated activities.

### **Payment Terms**

Bookings must be confirmed in writing by fax, email and/or registered letter and the deposit payment must be received before the Company can confirm in full to all subcontractors. Once the deposit is received and the booking is confirmed, all terms and conditions apply and our cancellation policies will be in immediate effect.

By confirmation of the booking, the Client acknowledges that all terms and conditions of the Company have been provided and accepted.

The full amount of the tour is payable not less than 60 days prior to the date when the tour commences.

In the event that a booking is not paid in full as per the above payment terms the Company reserves the right to refuse the Client(s) participation in the tour, and the client will be liable for any applicable cancellation fees.

### **CANCELLATIONS**

All cancellations should be made in writing and will only be deemed effective upon acknowledgment of receipt by the Company.

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Cancellations will be subject to the following penalties:

- 20% of the total booking fee shall be payable immediately upon confirmation.
- 50% of the total booking 45 - 90 days prior to commencement of the tour.
- 100% of the total booking 44 days or less prior to the commencement of the tour.

Standard Cancellation fees shall apply in instances of postponed departure dates.

### RESERVATIONS

Please be advised that for any quotes, no provisional bookings have been made unless otherwise specified by your consultant. Accommodation is subject to availability at the time of the booking.
